HOAG MEMORIAL HOSPITAL PRESBYTERIAN ANCILLARY BUILDING RENOVATION



This renovation expands the freestanding Emergency Department and upgrades the imaging technology.

Emergency Care Unit: The expansion increased the total treatment bays from 34 to 52. Extensive site work, includes a new entrance and covered patient drop-off. Scope encompasses 27,000 SF.

Imaging: The expansion includes a dedicated CT and General Rad room, 3 Nuclear Medicine rooms, 2 Image Guided US Procedure rooms, 4 Ultrasound rooms, 4 Rad /Fluoro, 1 General Rad Room, 12 reading rooms, pre-post procedure holding; and reconfigurating two MRI control rooms. Scope of work encompasses 23,000 SF.
